On October 2, 1992, from 6 - 10 pm, Galeria Las Americas will present an inaugural exhibition and celebrate its new name with an impressive group exhibition of contemporary Latin American artists represented by the gallery.

GALERIA LAS AMERICAS will begin its new calendar of revolving exhibitions set in a salon, artist studio atmosphere. Galeria Las Americas, formerly Galeria Nueva, is dedicated to contemporary Mexican, Chicano, and Latino Americano artists and collectorship.

The philosophy of "Full Spectrum" artist and collectorship is central to GALERIA LAS AMERICAS. "Full Spectrum" embraces and acknowledges the idea that there are many distinct voices within the Latin American community. Each voice, including all of the different emphases and viewpoints, is critical to the enhancement of the Latin American art movement, deserving respect and support.

In 1991, owner Linda Vallejo received an award of merit from the Comision Femenil de Los Angeles, a national Latin American women's professional organization, for her personal art work and entrepreneurial efforts in educating and developing a new Latin American market for fine arts.
